

THE majority of Lodges having adopted an emblematical design, the Lodge of Prudent Brethren, not being a juvenile, ought not to be destitute of the same; it is here attempted therefore, to symbolize the name and principles of our Lodge, with due observance to Masonic harmony.

The Centenarian Lodge of Prudent Brethren, No. 145, is represented by a double cube, with its brimful cornucopia adjoining; is emblematically presided over by Justice, personifying the W.M., assisted by the six other Stars.

*Justice*, by the inspiration of the *Radiant Triangle*, demonstrates *Hope* to the faithful; and, blindfold against prejudice, prudently practices towards the Widow and Orphan that virtue which endureth all things:

Thus illustrating *Faith*, *Hope*, and *Charity*, encircled by the symbol of *Eternity*.

“Let not thy left hand know what thy right hand doeth.”

is *Prudence*.
