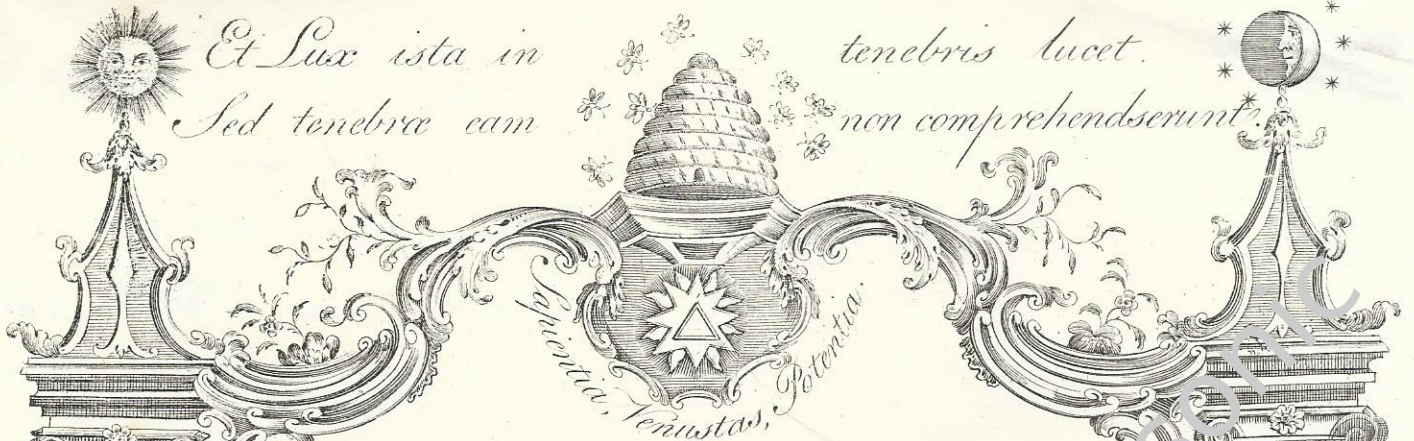

round the Globe.

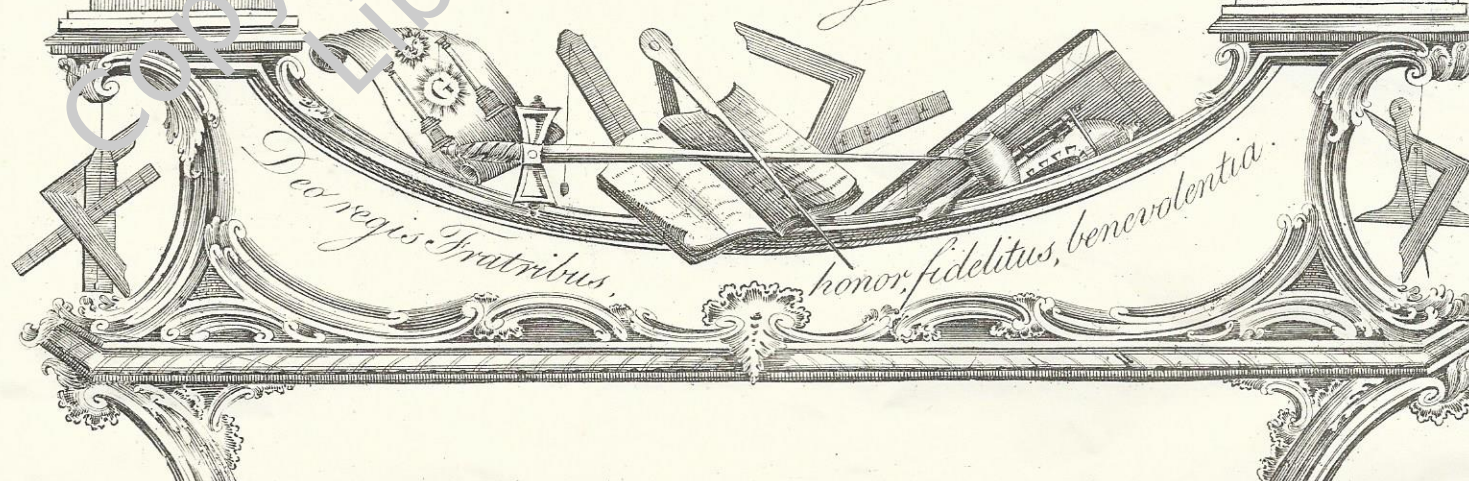
And to prevent any ill use being made of

in 1813 it became No. 20 its present No.
