It is with feelings of the most profound regret, that we make official announcement of the burning of a part of the Masonic Temple, in this city, on the morning of Wednesday, December 24th, 1884, by which our beautiful Cathedral, grand organ, costumes, robes, scenery, paraphernalia, etc., was entirely destroyed. Notwithstanding this serious, and, in many instances, irreparable loss, our Annual Reunion *will not be postponed*, and our annual visitors and brethren shall not be disappointed.

Our Board of Trustees, equal to any emergency, has secured the use of **ROBINSON'S OPERA-HOUSE**, situated on the North-East corner of Ninth and Plum Streets, and that beautiful Temple of the Drama will be the scene of the conferring of the various grades, being admirably adapted for the purpose. New properties, paraphernalia, costumes and robes, are being rapidly prepared, and the *work* will not materially suffer by reason of the fire.

We enclose this with our annual programme, which had been already prepared, and was ready for the mail when the fire stayed proceedings for the time being.

The dates (February 24, 25 & 26, 1885,) have not been changed, though the programme of *work* may have to be modified in some respects, but just where it is at present impossible to tell. We more than ever, earnestly invite the members of the Rite, wheresoever dispersed, to join with us in this coming Reunion, promising them a fraternal welcome and an hospitable entertainment.
