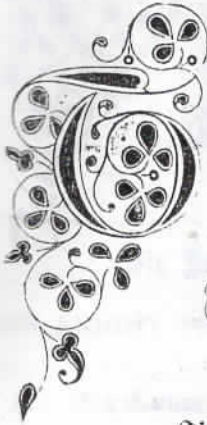


SPECIAL GRAND CONCLAVE.
