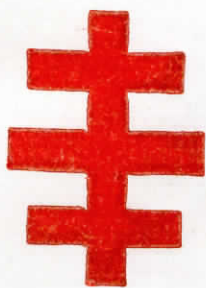

Grand Conclave of Knights Templar,

to be holden at the City Terminus Hotel, Cannon Street, London,
on Friday, the 10th day of May, A.D. 1872, at the hour of Three of the
Clock, prompt time.

The Grand Conclave will be opened in due time.
The Muster Roll will be called by the Grand Registrar.
The Minutes of the last Grand Conclave will be read.
A Motion that the Minutes are correctly recorded will be made.
The Report of the Committee will be read.
A Motion to confirm the Report will be made.
Motions pursuant to Notice will be made.
The Grand Treasurer will be elected.
The Grand Master will nominate and invest his Officers for the ensuing year.
The Members of the Committee will be appointed and elected.

At the conclusion of the business of Grand Conclave, should a sufficient number of
Knights signify to the Grand Director of Ceremonies, by the 3rd day of May, their desire
to be installed, the Grand Prior will hold under the Banner of the St. George's Encamp-
ment (London),

A Priory of the Order of Malta,

into which any Knight Templar who shall have so signified his desire can be admitted.
The fee will be One Guinea and a half, to include the Certificate.

A Grand Priory of the Order of Malta

will be held at the conclusion of the business of the Priory.

The Minutes of the last Grand Priory will be read.
A Motion that the Minutes are correctly recorded will be made.
The Report of the Committee will be read.
A Motion to confirm the Report will be made.

The Banquet will take place at the City Terminus Hotel, Cannon Street, at Six of the
Clock, under the Presidency of the M. C. and S. Grand Master,
or in his absence of the Deputy Grand Master.

NOTE.—Each PROVINCIAL GRAND COMMANDER should, if possible, attend Grand Conclave, or be represented by his Deputy.

EACH KNIGHT WHO HOLDS OFFICE in Grand Conclave must attend in his place by *Half-past Two* o'clock, or previously justify his intended absence, at least three days before, in order that a substitute may be appointed, otherwise Rule 2, page 12, of the Statutes relating to fines will be strictly enforced.—The attention of Grand Officers is particularly requested to the Report of the Committee presented to the Grand Conclave in May, 1870, on this subject.

Stalls will be appropriated to those only who intimate their intention to be present, by letter to the Grand Director of Ceremonies, on or before the 7th of May.

Knights of Malta are *admissible* at Grand or Private Pories in the costume of Knights Templar, but should bring with them the Mantle of Black with the White Cross of the Order, as well as the Templar Mantle.

N.B.—Dinner will be provided for those Knights only who intimate their intention to be present. Tickets One Guinea.
