The following provision has been added to Rule 175 Book of Constitutions:—

"175a. Should a member be three years in arrear, he shall thereupon cease to be a member of the Lodge, and can only become a member again by regular proposition and ballot according to Rule 189. The Lodge may require payment of the arrears as a condition precedent to election. This Rule shall not prevent a Lodge proceeding against any of its members, under Rule 210, for non-payment of contributions according to its bye-laws, for a shorter period than three years. When a Brother ceases to be a member under this Rule, the fact shall be forthwith notified to the Grand Secretary, and, if the Lodge be within a Province or District, also to the Provincial or District Grand Lodge. The provisions of Rule 211, 212, and 213 shall apply in such a case, as if the Brother had been excluded by vote."
