- 1.—To open Lodge at 7.0 o'clock punctually.
- 2.—To read and confirm the minutes of the last Regular Lodge.
- 3.—To elect the Worshipful Master for the ensuing year.
- 4.—To elect the Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- 5.—To elect the Tyler and Assistant Tyler for the ensuing year.
- 6.—To ballot for Mr. JOSEPH JOSELAND WOOD, of Ethelbert Lodge, London Road, Worcester; proposed by W.B. A. B. ROWE, seconded by the S.W.
- 7.—The following Resolution, proposed at the last meeting by W.B. A. B. ROWE, and seconded by the J.W., will be submitted for confirmation:—"That for Byelaw No. 2 there be substituted the following:—'The Lodge shall celebrate St. John's Day by a Banquet on the first Wednesday in December, the day of installation of the W.M. at 4 o'clock.
