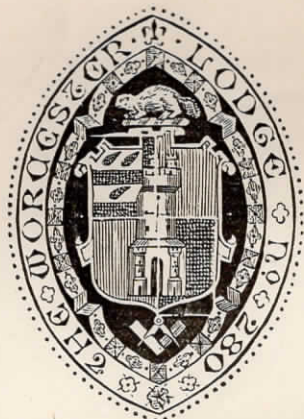


Ancient Free and Accepted Masons.

In consequence of the lamented death of Wor. Bro. T. LAMB SMITH, Treasurer and Steward of this Lodge, Brethren are requested to appear in Masonic Mourning (three black crape rosettes on Badge only).

Business.

- 1.—To open Lodge at 6 punctually.
- 2.—To read and confirm the minutes of the last Regular Lodge.
- 3.—To ballot for and (if elected) to initiate Mr. GEORGE MARCUS PANTON BRAINE HARTLAND, of Powick Surgeon; proposed by W. Bro. H. G. BUDD, P.M., and seconded by W. Bro. R. C. SMITH CARINGTON, P.M.
- 4.—To consider and discuss the following alterations and additions to the By-Laws:—
 - In By-Law No. 1.—To leave out the words "95, High Street."
 - In By-Law No. 2.—To insert the word "September" between May and October.
 - In By-Law No. 6.—To insert after the word Lodge in the first line, the words "admitted after September, 1882"; and in the last line, to substitute the word "April" for May.
 - In By-Law No. 7.—At the end of line five, to substitute the word "occupation" for addition.
 - In By-Law No. 14.—In line two, to insert "I.P.M." for P.M.; in line four, to substitute the word "January" for November; in lines five and six, to leave out the words "between the Regular Lodge, in that month, and day of Installation"; and in the last line to substitute the word "January" for Installation.
 - In By-Law No. 15.—In the lines ten and eleven, to leave out the words "after his Installation at that Meeting."
 - In By-Law No. 16.—To omit the last sentence.
 - In By-Law No. 19.—To add at the end the sentence omitted in By-Law 16, substituting the word "Steward's" for Secretary.
 - In By-Law No. 25.—In line six, to substitute the words "invited to do so by the W.M.," instead of "requested by the Master."
- 5.—To receive Subscriptions due.
- 6.—To transact any other business which may arise for the good of Masonry in general, or Lodge in particular.
