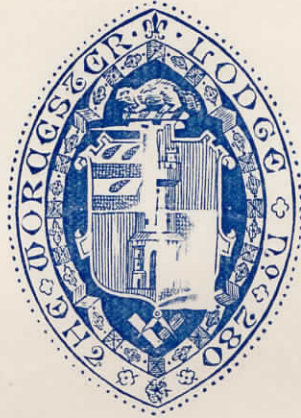


Ancient Free and Accepted Masons.
