BY THE THREE CONSTITUTIONS IN CEYLON.

Dear Sir and Brother,

After the Communication of District Grand Lodge on Wednesday, May 4th, 1932, it is proposed to have a United Masonic Farewell Dinner to Rt. Wor. Bro. A. Woodeson, on his departure from Ceylon.

The Dinner will be held in the Grand Oriental Hotel, Colombo, on May 4th, 1932. The total charge will not exceed Rs. 7.50 per head *without* drinks and this sum (or such lesser amount found necessary) will be collected during the evening from those dining, by Stewards specially appointed. Drinks will be paid for at the time of ordering, direct to the Hotel representatives.

For the benefit of Up-country Brethren attending the Banquet and spending the night at the Hotel, the Manager has agreed to an inclusive charge of Rs. 10.00 to comprise Banquet, Apartment, Early Tea, and Breakfast. In addition to this, Up-country Brethren will have to pay the Lodge Stewards Rs. 2.50 (or less) as per capita amount of the incidental expenses of the Dinner. The total cost to Up-country Brethren will thus be not more than Rs. 12.50 per head.

There will only be one Guest, as the Farewell is from the Brethren of all three Constitutions equally.

If you can attend the Dinner, will you please fill up the attached slip and post it in the enclosed addressed envelope to reach the Secretary, Victoria Masonic Temple, by April 15th, if possible. It will greatly facilitate arrangements if all replies are received by the 15th, but as it is recognized that this may not be possible in some cases, the List will not be finally closed on that date.

All Master Masons are invited to attend the 53rd Communication of District Grand Lodge in the Victoria Masonic Temple at 6.15 p.m., on May 4th, and on this occasion a special invitation is extended to Master Masons of the Irish and Scottish Constitutions. The Masters of Lodges meeting before May 4th, are requested to notify their Brethren of the functions arranged for that evening.
