- To receive the Audited Accounts of the Provincial Grand Treasurer, and if approved to adopt the same.
- To elect a Provincial Grand Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- To receive the report of the Charity Committee enclosed herewith.
- To elect the Hon. Secretary of the Charity Organisation.
- To receive the Provincial Grand Secretary's report of the contributions to the Prince of Wales Fund.
- The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master will propose that Bylaw No. 5 be altered by inserting "Director of Ceremonies, £2 2s." next after Secretary, and before Deacons £2 2s., in the list of Fees of Honour.
- To receive the report of the Library and Museum Committee enclosed herewith.
- To call the muster roll of the Lodges.
- The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint and invest his Officers.
- The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint one Member of the General Committee under Bylaw No. 6.
- To elect two Brethren to serve on General Committee, under Bylaw No. 6.
- To receive fees of honour from Provincial Grand Officers.
- The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint place for holding the next Annual Meeting of Provincial Grand Lodge.
- An Address to be given by the Provincial Grand Chaplain, after which a collection will be made for a charitable purpose.
