# Business.

*A Craft Lodge will be opened in the three degrees by the W.M. of the "Masefield" Lodge, No. 2034, at 1.45 p.m.*

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master and Provincial Grand Officers will enter the Lodge, and having been received with the customary honours, the Provincial Grand Lodge will be opened in due form at **2.15 p.m.**

The Minutes of the last Annual Provincial Grand Lodge held at Worcester 23rd September, 1896, and a Memorandum relating to the Consecration of the "Arter" Lodge No. 2654, at Moseley, on the 19th March, 1897, to be read for confirmation.

To read apologies for absence.

To receive the report on the state of Masonry in the Province.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master will call upon the W.M. of each Lodge in the Province to give a **brief** statement concerning the work of his Lodge during the past year, and any facts of interest relating thereto.

The Provincial Grand Treasurer's Accounts having been audited, a motion will be made that the same be received and adopted.

To receive the report of the Charity Committee.

To elect a Secretary to the Charity Committee for the ensuing year.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master, in accordance with notice given at the last Provincial Grand Lodge Meeting, will propose :

That a further sum of 25 guineas be voted from the funds of Provincial Grand Lodge to the "Lechmere Memorial" donation to the R.M. Benevolent Institution.

Worshipful Brother WILLIAM WALDRON, P.F.S.G.W., will propose :

That a sum of £5 5 0 is still required to complete the "Lechmere Memorial" donation of 100 guineas each respectively to the R.M. Institutions for the Boys and for the Girls, that same be voted from the funds of Provincial Grand Lodge.

To receive the report of the Library and Museum Committee.

To receive any presentations to the Library and Museum.

To appoint Committee to revise Provincial Grand Lodge By-Laws.

The Muster Roll of the Lodges will be called.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint and invest his Provincial Grand Officers.

To receive fees of honour from Provincial Grand Officers.

The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint place for holding his next Provincial Grand Lodge.

An Address will be given by the Provincial Grand Chaplain, after which a collection will be made on behalf of the Royal Masonic Charities.

To transact any other business that may arise for the good of the Order in general or of this Provincial Grand Lodge in particular.
