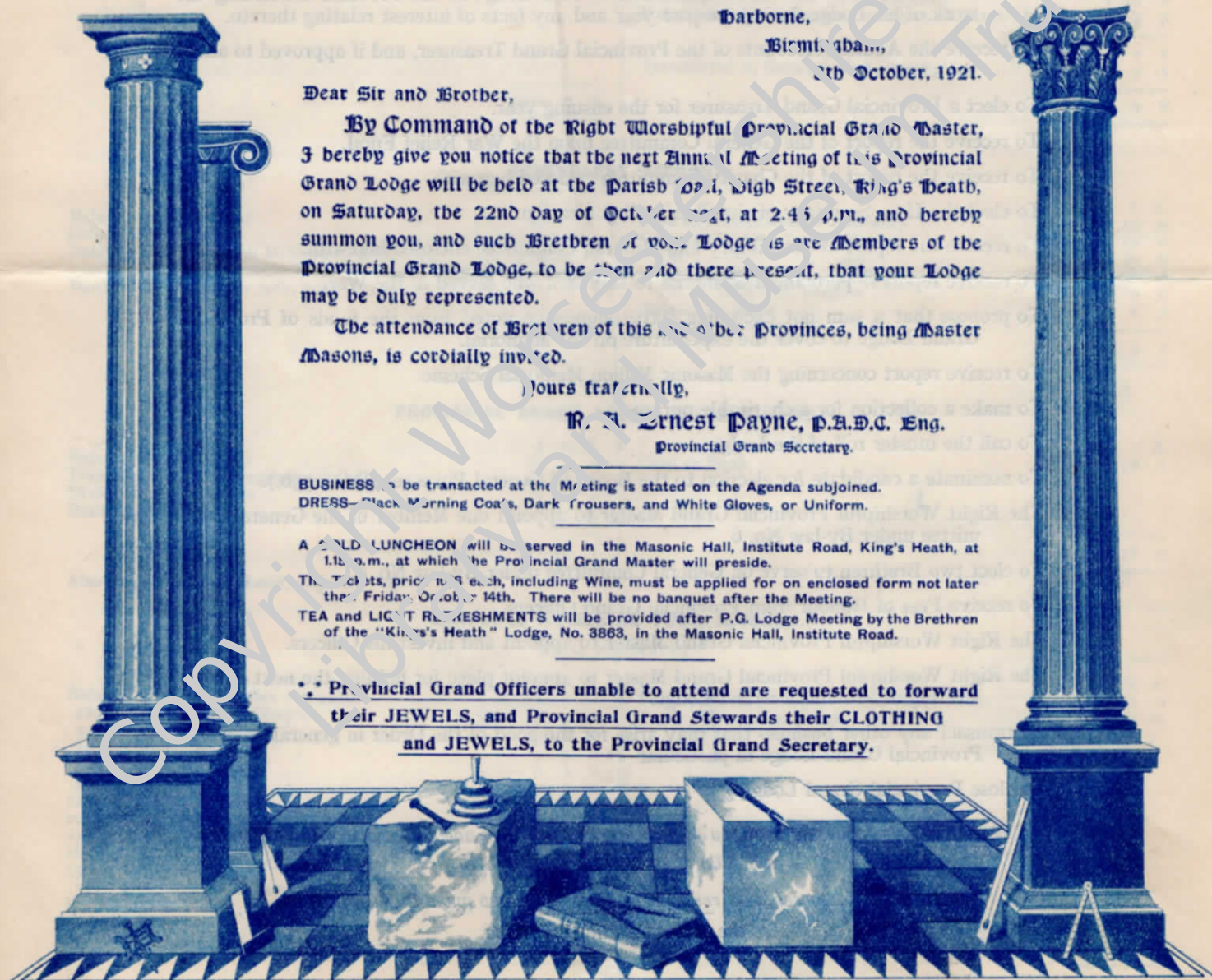
BUSINESS to be transacted at the Meeting is stated on the Agenda subjoined.
