Business.

1. The Companions will take their places in the Chapter.
2. The M.E. the Grand Superintendent and Provincial Grand Officers will enter the Chapter and Provincial Grand Chapter will be opened.
3. The Circular convening the Convocation will be read.
4. The Minutes of the last Convocation will be read and put for confirmation.
5. The Provincial Grand Treasurer's Accounts having been audited, motion will be made that the same be received and adopted.
6. The Treasurer will be elected.
7. The Muster Roll of Chapters will be called, and the number representing each Chapter recorded.
8. The Officers for the ensuing year will be appointed and invested.
9. The Janitor will be appointed.
10. The Fees of Honour will be received from the Provincial Grand Officers.
11. The Patent of Appointment of Comp. Page as Grand Superintendent of Worcestershire will be presented.
12. The M.E. the Grand Superintendent will appoint place for holding the next Provincial **Grand Chapter.**
13. The Prov. Grand H. Ex Comp. William Waldron will present the Grand Superintendent, on behalf of the Ex Companions and Companions, with a piece of Silver Plate suitably inscribed, to mark their satisfaction and appreciation of the signal honour conferred on him by the First Grand Principal, H.R.H. The Duke of Connaught and Strathearn, K.G.
14. Alms will be collected.
15. Any other business not requiring notice will be considered.
16. The Provincial Grand Chapter will be closed.

The Banquet will take place punctually at 5.45 o'clock.
