Business.

1. The Circular convening the Convocation will be read.
2. The Minutes of the last Convocation will be read and put for confirmation.
3. To receive the Provincial Scribe E's report on the state of Royal Arch Masonry in the Province.
4. To receive a brief statement from the First Principal of each Chapter concerning the Work of his Chapter during the past year.
5. The Provincial Grand Treasurer's Accounts having been audited, as per Balance Sheet enclosed, a motion will be made that the same be received and adopted.
6. The Treasurer will be elected.
7. The Muster Roll of Chapters will be called and the number representing each Chapter recorded.
8. To collect Alms.
9. The Officers for the ensuing year will be appointed and invested.
10. The Janitor will be appointed.
11. The M. E. the Grand Superintendent will propose that a sum be voted from the Funds of the Provincial Grand Chapter to the Royal Masonic Institution for Boys, 1925 Festival.
12. Alteration to By-Laws.—The M. Ex. the Grand Superintendent will propose an addition to the By-laws, to be numbered 6 (a) and to read as follows :—

“The cost of conducting the affairs of the Provincial Grand Chapter shall be a first charge on the Revenue thereof, and any Credit Balance which may be shewn on the Audited Accounts of the Provincial Grand Treasurer, shall, without motion or amendment thereon, pass to the Benevolent Fund.”
13. The Fees of Honour will be received from the Provincial Grand Officers.
14. The M.E. the Grand Superintendent will appoint place for holding the next **Provincial Grand Chapter.**
15. Any other business not requiring notice will be considered.
16. Provincial Grand Chapter will be closed.
