- The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint and invest his Provincial Grand Officers.
- To receive fees of honour from Provincial Grand Officers.
- The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master to appoint place for holding his next Annual Convocation of Provincial Grand Lodge.
- An Address to be given by the Provincial Grand Chaplain, after which a collection will be made for a charitable purpose.
- To transact any other business that may arise for the good of the order in general or of this Provincial Grand Lodge in particular.
- To close Provincial Grand Lodge.
