# Agenda.

- I. The Brethren of the various Lodges, except present and past Officers of the Provincial Grand Lodge of Worcestershire, are requested to be seated under their respective banners by 2.15.
- II. At 2.30 the W. Bro. W. T. PAGE, P.A.G.D. of C., P. Prov. G. Sec., Deputy Provincial Grand Master in Charge, together with the Present and Past Grand Officers of the Province will enter the hall in procession.
- III. Provincial Grand Lodge will be opened in Form.
- IV. The W. Deputy Provincial Grand Master will be saluted according to ancient custom.
- V. The Most Worshipful the Pro Grand Master, the RIGHT HONOURABLE THE LORD AMPHILL, G.C.S.I., G.C.I.E., and Officers of Grand Lodge, present and past, will be received.
- VI. The Pro Grand Master, having taken his seat on the Throne, will be saluted.
- VII. Other Officers of Grand Lodge will be saluted.
- VIII. The circular convening the Meeting will be read.
- IX. Letters and communications will be read by the Prov. Grand Secretary.
- X. The Installing Master will address the Provincial Grand Lodge with special reference to the Installation of Right Worshipful Brother GENERAL WILLIAM CAMPBELL, C.B., P.G.D., etc. as Grand Master of this Province.
- XI. The arrival of the Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master (Designate) will be announced.
- XII. The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will be requested to send in his Patent.
- XIII. The Director of Ceremonies will retire and bring in the Patent, and present it to the Installing Master.
- XIV. The M.W. the Installing Master, having examined the Patent, will direct a Deputation of seven Past Masters to retire with the Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies and introduce the R.W. Provincial Grand Master (designate), and place him before the pedestal.

- XV. The Provincial Grand Secretary will be directed to read the Patent.
- XVI. Prayer by the Provincial Grand Chaplain.

- XVII. The M.W. the Installing Master will address the R.W. Provincial Grand Master (designate), and enquire if he can conscientiously undertake the duties of the office.
- XVIII. The R.W. Provincial Grand Master (designate) will kneel and take the O.B. **He will then be invested with the Apron, Chain and Jewel of Office, and placed in the Chair.**
- XIX. The M.W. the Installing Master will be conducted to the Chair on the left of the R.W. Provincial Grand Master.
- XX. **The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will be proclaimed and saluted.**
- XXI. The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will appoint his deputy, and direct the Provincial Grand Secretary to read the Patent.
- XXII. The W. Deputy Provincial Grand Master will be conducted by the Provincial Grand Deacons to the front of the Pedestal.
- XXIII. The W. Deputy Provincial Grand Master will be addressed by the R.W. Provincial Grand Master on the duties of his office, obligated, invested, and placed in the Chair.
- XXIV. **The W. Deputy Provincial Grand Master will be proclaimed and saluted.**
- XXV. The R.W. Provincial Grand Master will appoint and invest the other Provincial Grand Officers.
- XXVI. The Provincial Grand Treasurer will be elected and invested.
- XXVII. The Provincial Grand Tyiers will be appointed.
- XXVIII. The Provincial Grand Officers will be saluted.
- XXIX. A Committee will be appointed to revise the by-laws.
- XXX. Any other business deemed necessary to give effect to the special object of the Meeting will be considered.
- XXXI. Provincial Grand Lodge will be closed, and the Grand and Provincial Grand Officers will retire.
