# THE ROYAL STANDARD LODGE

No. 835

was established in Halifax by a warrant dated March 10th, 1829. The first officers were as follows :

In 1833 the number was changed to 564, and again in 1863 to 398.

In 1869 when the Grand Lodge of Nova Scotia was formed by the Union of the Lodges working under the Grand Lodges of England and Scotland, ROYAL STANDARD LODGE retained firm in its allegiance to the Mother Grand Lodge, and is now the only Lodge in Nova Scotia working under a charter from the Grand Lodge of England.
