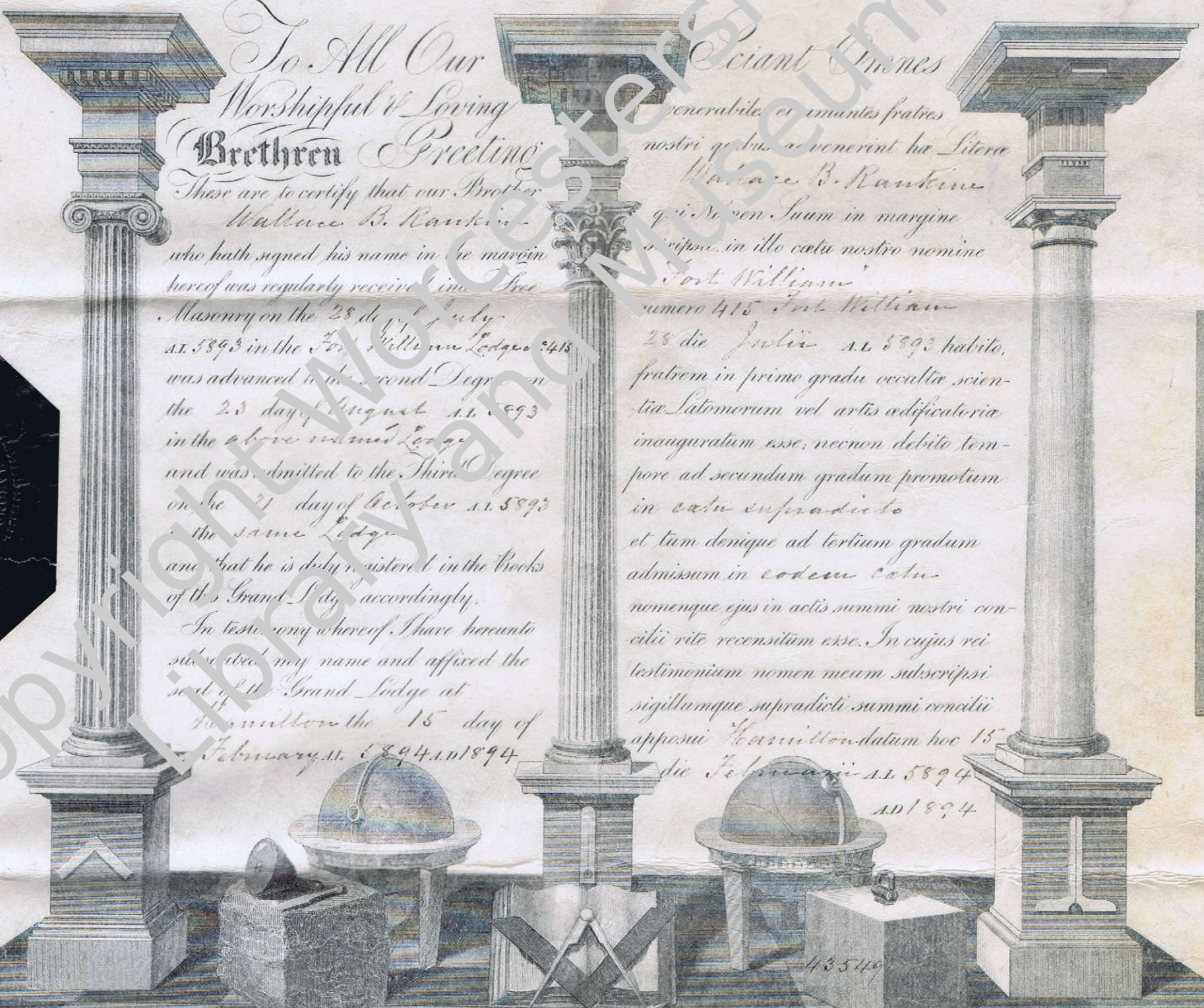
These are to certify that our Brother
