FROM THE REPORT OF THE BOARD OF GENERAL PURPOSES

ATTENDANCE AT LODGES OVERSEAS.

The Board receives information from time to time of cases where members of Lodges go abroad and become involved, generally through ignorance, with Masonic bodies not recognised as regular by the United Grand Lodge. The Board wishes to draw attention to this danger, and to point out that the best method of combating it is for Lodges to impress upon their members that they should not make any Masonic contacts overseas with Masons of other Jurisdictions without having ascertained by application to the Grand Secretary at Freemasons Hall the existence of regular Masonry in the country concerned, and the address to which Masonic enquiries in that country should be directed.
