(a), (b) and (c) be rescinded and the following be substituted:-

- (a) Subject to Rule III the Annual subscription shall be two pound's evelve shillings and sixpence payable in advance at each Installation when in the first subscription for a Brother initiated or joining at any meeting after the second meeting subsequent to the Installation Meeting shall be one pound seven shillings and should be one pound seven shillings and should be seven shillings and should be seven shillings.
- (b) Subject to Rule III the Annual subscription, excluding banquetting fees, for Service members on the Active List of H.M. Forces serving outside the United Kingdom, shall be one pound one shilling.
- (c) The charge for each banquet for Violtors and for each Brother who Notifies the Steward of His Intention to By Present shall be such sum as may be fixed from time to time by the Senior Steward in consultation with the Lodge Standing Committee.
