## Labour of the Lodge

1. To open the Lodge at 5.45 p.m. prompt.
2. To read the Summons convening the Meeting.
3. To read and, if approved, confirm the Minutes of the last Regular Meeting held on Thursday, January 22nd, 1942.
4. A Paper will be rendered.
5. To receive subscriptions now **due**: £3 5s. (or £3 3s. from Brethren who pay to the Masonic Building Fund through any other Lodge meeting in the City of Worcester).
6. To read apologies.
7. To collect alms.
8. W. Bro. Bunting will propose and W. Bro. F. L. Carter will second "That Bye-Law paras. (a), (b) and (c) be rescinded and the following be substituted:—  
(a) Subject to Rule III the Annual subscription shall be two pounds twelve shillings and sixpence payable in advance at each Installation Meeting. The first subscription for a Brother initiated or joining at any meeting after the second meeting subsequent to the Installation Meeting shall be one pound seven shillings and sixpence.  
(b) Subject to Rule III the Annual subscription, excluding banqueting fees, for Service members on the Active List of H.M. Forces serving outside the United Kingdom, shall be one pound one shilling.  
(c) The charge for each banquet for Visitors and for each Brother who NOTIFIES THE STEWARD OF HIS INTENTION TO BE PRESENT shall be such sum as may be fixed from time to time by the Senior Steward in consultation with the Lodge Standing Committee.  
That the addition made to Bye-Law II, which was approved by the Grand Master on 6th April, 1932, be rescinded.  
These alterations to the Bye-Laws to take place as from the Installation Meeting of the year 1942 and that when approved they shall be sent in the form of a printed amendment slip to all members of the Lodge."
9. Bro. Higgins will propose and the Worshipful Master will second "That the Prov. G. Master be asked to grant that—under the emergency powers given by Grand Lodge Ruling dated the 6th December, 1939—permission be given that:—Provided that the regular status of the W.M. or of any officer of the Lodge be not affected thereby, the September and November (Installation) regular meetings for 1942 be held on the 4th Thursdays in June and September respectively, the September meeting being deemed the Installation meeting; and that thereafter for the duration of this War or until otherwise arranged the meetings of Fort Royal Lodge shall take place on the 4th Thursday in the months of March, May, July and September."
