Notices.

1. Since the temporary suspension of meetings of which Brethren were notified, United Grand Lodge has decided to permit the resumption of meetings subject to special conditions which leave most of the details in the hands of the W.M. subject to the instructions of the R. W. Prov. G. Master.

Those that affect the ordinary routine are briefly that meetings shall be held early in the day and that the after-proceedings shall be brief and simple. Morning Dress or Uniform will be worn. Meetings may be cancelled, altered or arranged other than in accordance with our Bye-Laws, etc. etc.

2. Accordingly, among other matters the W.M. in consultation with the Lodge Standing Committee, has decided that any member of this Lodge if and when called for National Service outside the Masonic Province, may if his financial status so requires it pay an annual subscription of One Guinea in place of the present full subscription as from the year commencing 1st November, 1939.

In this connection United Grand Lodge points out that the benevolent side of the Craft with its various Benevolent Institutions and the administration thereof must be maintained, and that these probably will be subjected to far greater calls upon their funds now, than in normal times. It is therefore hoped that all Brethren will try and help those whose needs are greater than their own by ever greater generosity than usual. It is expected therefore that unless members on service outside the Province are under financial disability they will at least continue their usual subscriptions. Any member desiring to make the change referred to should notify the Secretary.

3. It is hoped that members who are On Service will try as far as possible to keep touch with the Secretary whose especial duty and pleasure it is to maintain frequent contact with all Brethren who may be absent from our meetings on Service during this time of National Emergency and state of War.
