- The Grand Chapter Officers will be saluted. 5

- 7 The Second Prov. G. Prin. offers the Introductory Priver.

- The Director of Ceremonies arranges the Founders in the 10

- 30 Before the FOURTH circuit, Prov. G. Scribe N. eao. Leviticus ii y. 13, and then the Companions sing :

- Fourth Perambulation. The Consecrating Officer sprin les salt-the symbol of Friendship 31 and Fidelity. utus-"Glory be to God on high."
- The Director of Ceremonies relives Principals of the Consecrating Vessels and they take their 32places in front of their Ch. ir.
- The Consecrating Office, D dicates the Chap er. 33
