Degrees appendant thereunto, holden at Newcastle-upon-Tyne, by virtue of the powers inherent in us

Do hereby certify and declare that the Knight Companion William Samuel Burton  
a member of the Richard Coeur de Lion Preceptory of Knights of the Holy Temple, etc, and of the Royal Arch Chapter Campbell  
N<sup>o</sup> 3643 on the Roll of the Supreme Grand Chapter of England, and an installed Master of the Campbell  
Lodge N<sup>o</sup> 3643 on the Roll of the United Grand Lodge of England, being well known to and held in high esteem amongst  
us as a Brother, Companion, and Knight, was, upon the Twenty-sixth day of the month of May  
in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-one admitted a Funeral Master, Master of the  
Blue, Excellent, Mason and Master, Sublime Master, Tugitive Mark, Architect and Knight of the Three Kings, installed  
a Knight of Patmos, of Redemption, of Death, of the Christian Mark, of Bethany, of Eleusis, of the Cross, of the Black Cross  
of the White Cross, of the White Cross of Torphichen, of the Suspended Cross, of Babylon, of St John the Baptist, and of the Triple Cross,  
and enthroned as a Grand Cross of St. John, made free from Harodim, etc, and anointed and ordained into this Grand and Holy Order  
of Holy Wisdom, or Royal Arch Knight Templar Priest as a Priest of the Tabernacle, and entrusted with all the sublime and  
mysterious knowledge appertaining to his exalted rank according to antient usage.
