The Masonic and Military Order of the Red Cross of Constantine.

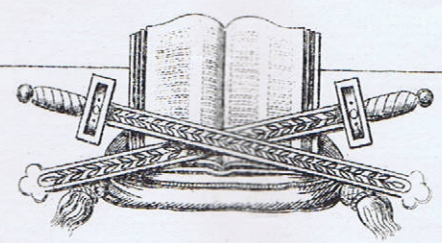
