E.& P. P. You are now aware that you have oeen admitted to a Christian order in Masonry in which you have taken an Obligation on the H.& U. Frinity. You will no doubt have noticed that there is no penalty in your colligation your promise as a Christian being sufficient.

There are two Christian Orders in Masonry with which you may come in contact, the other being the K. T., which is based upon the Unristianity of the Crusades, and may be likened to active Christian Easonry; whereas this degree is based upon the Crucifiction and Respurection of Our Lord, and may be likened to contemplative or mystical Christian Mesoury in which we look for the LOST WORD.

We learn that "In the beginning was the bord" - What Word? The ancients called it YAHWEY and later we learn "The word was GOE' in this ceremony we discover the Word - It is E----1.

During the Intermediate Degrees you were given the sign in the 17th degree by placing the arms in the form of a St. Andrew's Cross.

Again later in the Accolede and the malanation of the collar you were given the sign with the arms crossing in the form of two St. Andrew's Crosses. We may thus take this cross as the sign of this degree.

St. Andrew was the first disciple of our Lord who brought his brother Simon Peter to Jesus Cirist. St Andrew preached extensively in Asia Minor and in Greece and was ultimately crucified in Patras on a diagonal cross with the arms and logs extended in the form of St. Andrew's Cross.

As ir other degree: in Masonry there is a Fire which you will receive here for the first time. It is based on the St. Andrew's Cross and is given SILENTLY and with FEVETENCE. It signifies our faith in our Risen Lord -Our Gt. 1.

To make this sign touch LS, RH. RS. LH. and then look and point forward to the WAY we are to go :- TO OUR Gt. E.
