

Order of Proceedings.

The Knights will assemble in the Temple by 2.30 p.m.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master, accompanied by the Great Officers will enter in procession under the Arch of Steel at 2.45 p.m.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master will assume the Throne, appoint his Officers, open a Chapter of Provincial Priory and be saluted.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master will address the Knights.

The Great Marshal will announce that the Very Eminent Knight Edward Lancelot Bunting, M.B., Provincial Prior Nominate, is without.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master will direct the Great Marshal to conduct the Very Eminent Provincial Prior Nominate into the Priory.

The Arch of Steel will be formed.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior Nominate will enter.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master will demand the Patent, which will be read by the Great Vice-Chancellor.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master will announce that he is ready to proceed with the Installation.

The Great Prelate will offer Prayer.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior Nominate will kneel and recite the Obligation.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior Nominate will be led to the East by the Great Prelate, pay Homage, be Invested and Installed.

The Great Prelate will pronounce the Benediction.

The Great Herald will proclaim the Very Eminent Provincial Prior from the West.

The Great Marshal will call on the Knights to salute the Very Eminent Provincial Prior.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior will appoint his Sub-Prior and order his Patent to be read.

The Very Eminent Provincial Sub-Prior Nominate will be conducted to the West of the Sepulchre and will be addressed by the Very Eminent Provincial Prior, be obligated, raised and led to the East by the Great Prelate, pay Homage and be Installed.

The Very Eminent Provincial Sub-Prior will be proclaimed and saluted.

The Provincial By-Laws will be submitted for confirmation.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior will confirm the Provincial Officers appointed at King's Heath on 14th September 1937.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior will address the Knights and propose a Vote of Thanks to the Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master.

Alms will be collected and the Templar's Hymn will be sung.

The Most Eminent and Supreme Grand Master, accompanied by the Great Officers, will retire under the Arch of Steel.

Any other Business for the good of the Order or the benefit of the Province will be considered.

Provincial Privy will be closed in due form.
