## LABOUR OF THE LODGE.

1. At 4 p.m. promptly, the Worshipful Master, Officers and Brethren will take their respective places in the Lodge Room.
2. Opening Hymn.
3. The Lodge will be opened.
4. The Rt. W. Provincial Grand Master, accompanied by the Wor. Deputy Prov. Grand Master, the Wor. Assistant Prov. Grand Master, Grand Lodge Officers and Provincial Grand Lodge Officers will enter in procession
5. The Rt. W. Provincial Grand Master will take the chair.
6. The Secretary will read the Summons convening the Meeting.
7. The Secretary will read the Minutes of the last regular Lodge Meeting.
8. The Report of the Lodge of Instruction will be read.
9. The Rt. W. Provincial Grand Master will address the Brethren on the object of the Meeting and call on the Secretary of the Lodge to read the Original Warrant of the Royal Standard Lodge.
10. The Secretary will read the Minutes of the first Meeting of the Lodge holden on 12th June, 1844.
11. The Rt. W. Provincial Grand Master will call upon the Provincial Grand Secretary to read the Centenary Warrant of the Lodge.
12. The Rt. W. Provincial Grand Master will call upon the Worshipful Master to resume the chair and present to him the Centenary Warrant granted by the M.W. Grand Master.
13. The Worshipful Master will acknowledge same.
14. The Worshipful Master will ask the Secretary to read a short history of the Lodge.
15. The Chaplain will give a short oration.
16. A Collection will be taken.
17. National Anthem.
18. The Rt. W. Provincial Grand Master, the Deputy Provincial Grand Master, the Assistant Provincial Grand Master, Grand Lodge Officers and Provincial Grand Lodge Officers will retire from the Lodge.
19. The Lodge will be closed.
