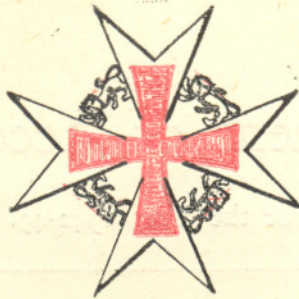

The Provincial Registrar will call the Muster Roll of the Provincial Officers.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior, the Provincial Sub-Prior and the Officers of Great Priory will be saluted.

Letters of Apology will be read.

The Minutes of the Meeting of Provincial Priory, held at Dudley, on the 8th September, 1942, will be read and put for confirmation.

The Provincial Registrar will call the Muster Roll of the Preceptories, and each Eminent Preceptor, or his Representative, will report on the state of his Preceptory.

The Provincial Treasurer's Statement of Accounts as attached will be submitted for adoption.

The Provincial Treasurer for the ensuing year will be elected.

The Very Eminent Provincial Prior will appoint the place for holding the next Annual Meeting of Provincial Priory.

The Provincial Priory will be closed, and the Very Eminent Provincial Prior, the Officers of Great Priory and of Provincial Priory will retire under the Arch of Steel.
