In July 1888: was appointed Secretary of the Lodge
which appointment he held until July 1891, when
he was selected to fill the J. G.'s Chair, promoted
to the Senior Warden in July 1892 - Elected and
Installed W. M. in July 1893. Under his management
over the Lodge that capacity until October 1904 -
When after installing his successor, the fact was
ever beloved ^{Mr} brother ~~Mr~~ John Henry Richardson
- By whose untimely death the community at
large lost a worthy and large-hearted citizen
and a remarkable brother whose great and noble
true character was manifest - - - was again appointed
Secretary of the Lodge, the duties of which he has since
zealously performed up to the present time with
performance with great care and fidelity, with him
the principles of the Craft has never swerved
or faltered. In 1894 was appointed both officer
