without due Examination.

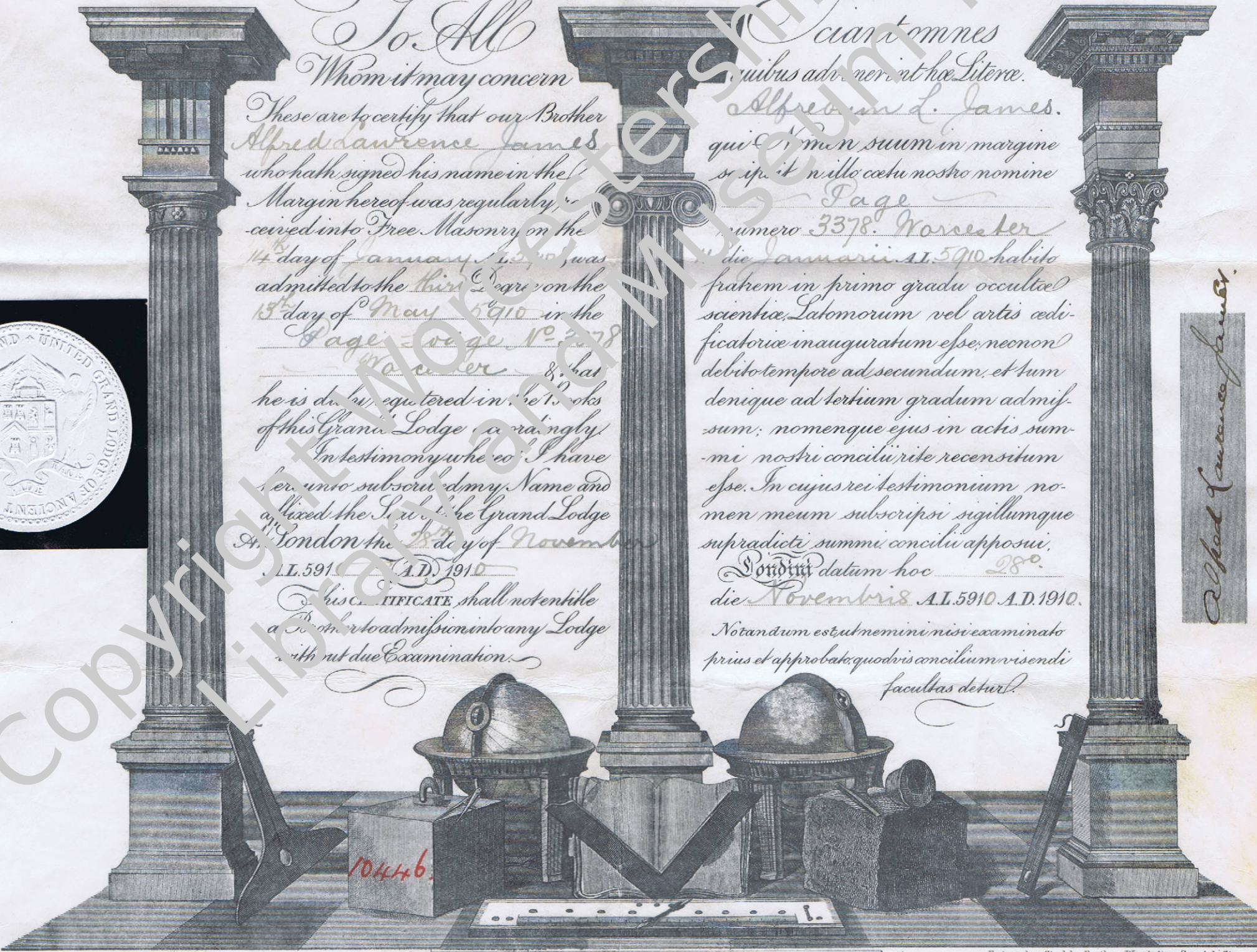
