Order of Procedure.

1. Provincial Grand Chapter will be opened by the Pro First Grand Principal, The Right Hon. the Lord Amphill, G.C.S.I., G.C.I.E., assisted by Officers of the Supreme Grand Chapter.
2. The Summons convening the Meeting will be read.
3. The Roll of Chapters will be called.
4. The M.E. the Pro First Grand Principal will address the Brethren and state the object of the Meeting.
5. The arrival of the Grand Superintendent Designate, E Comp. WILLIAM THOMAS PAGE, will be announced.
6. The M.E. Pro First Grand Principal will instruct the Grand Director of Ceremonies to retire and ask the Grand Superintendent Designate for his Patent, which on his return he will present to the M.E. Pro First Grand Principal.
7. The M.E. Pro First Grand Principal, having examined the Patent will direct a Deputation of Principals or Past Principals to retire with the Grand Director of Ceremonies, and introduce the Grand Superintendent Designate.
(All stand to order on his entrance.)
8. The Grand Scribe E. will be directed to read the Patent.
9. The M.E. Pro First Grand Principal will address the Grand Superintendent Designate, and enquire if he can conscientiously undertake the duties of the Office.
10. Prayer by the Acting Grand J.
11. The Grand Superintendent Designate will kneel and take the O.B., after which he will be Invested and placed in the Chair.

12. The M.E. Pro First Grand Principal will be conducted to the Chair on the right of the Grand Superintendent.
13. The Grand Superintendent will re-appoint the Second and Third Provincial Grand Principals who will be duly Invested.
14. The Grand Director of Ceremonies will proclaim, and the Companions will pass the Grand Superintendent in procession, saluting him and the other two Principals in passing.
15. The election of the Provincial Grand Treasurer will be confirmed.
16. The Appointment of other Provincial Officers will be confirmed.
17. The Bye Laws of the Province will be submitted for approval.
18. Resolutions and Votes of Thanks will be proposed and any other business deemed necessary to give effect to the special object of the Meeting.
19. Provincial Grand Chapter will be closed.

It is particularly desired that all Companions be seated by 2.45 p.m.

Tea will be provided at the Masonic Hall, after the closing of Provincial Grand Lodge.
