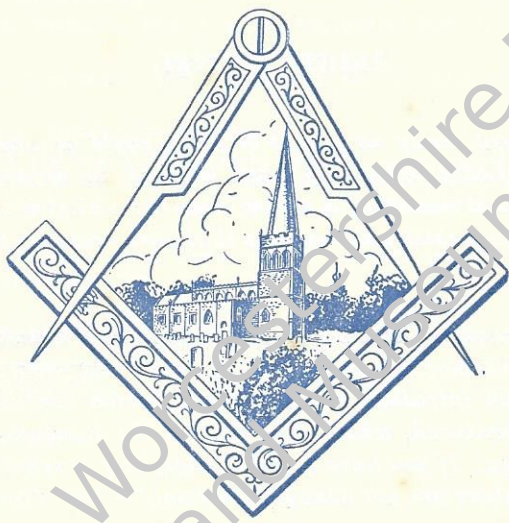

Antient Charge.
