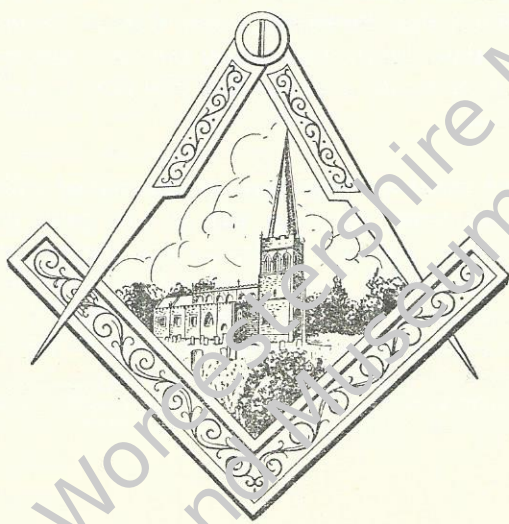

## Antient Charge.

*From antient times no master or fellow could be absent from his Lodge, especially when warned to appear at it, without incurring a severe censure: unless he appeared to the master and wardens that pure necessity hindered him.*

*"Be very cautious whom you recommend as a Candidate for Initiation: one false step on this point may be fatal. If you introduce a disputatious person confusion will be produced, which may end in the dissolution of the Lodge. If you have a good Lodge, keep it select. Great numbers are not always beneficial."*—DR. OLIVER.

12. To elect the Audit Committee for the ensuing year.
13. Pursuant to Notice of Motion, Wor. Bro. R. R. Mason, Prov.A.G.D.C., Treasurer, will propose "That a sum of money be taken from the Lodge Funds to purchase a Past Master's Jewel for the retiring Worshipful Master."
14. To receive propositions.
15. To receive subscriptions.
16. To transact any other business not requiring Notice of Motion.
17. To close the Lodge.
