## ORDER OF PROCEEDINGS.

**2.30 p.m.** Brethren, other than present or past Grand Officers and present Provincial Grand Officers, will take their places in the Lodge room.

**2.40 p.m.** **The Very Worshipful Deputy Provincial Grand Master in Charge** and the Officers of Provincial Grand Lodge will enter in Procession and Provincial Grand Lodge will be opened in form.

**3.0 p.m.** **The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** and the Officers of Grand Lodge will enter in Procession.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will take the Chair, appoint his Officers, and be saluted.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will be informed that the Provincial Grand Master Designate is without, and requests to be installed.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will request that the Patent of approval and appointment by the Most Worshipful Grand Master be produced to him.

**The Grand Director of Ceremonies** will retire and re-enter with the Patent, which he will present for inspection by the Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will direct that the Provincial Grand Master Designate be introduced in proper form.

**The Grand Director of Ceremonies** and certain appointed Brethren will retire, and preceded by Brethren bearing the Regalia, will re-enter the Lodge, introducing the Provincial Grand Master Designate.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will call upon the Grand Secretary to read the Patent.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will address the Provincial Grand Master Designate on the nature of his duties, and the qualifications for the Office to which he has been appointed, and will request him to advance and take a solemn O.B.; which being done

**The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master** will be conducted to the right of the Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master, by whom he will be invested, and installed.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master** will then be conducted to his Seat.

**The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master** will be proclaimed and saluted.

**The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master** will announce the appointment of Very Wor. Bro. Harry Vincent Stanton, P.G.Ov., P.P.G.W., as Deputy Provincial Grand Master, and direct his patent to be read.

**The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master** will address him on the duties of his office, and enquire as to his willingness to take the O.B., and having given his assent he will be obligated, invested, and installed.

**The Deputy Provincial Grand Master** will be proclaimed and saluted.

**The Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master** will confirm the appointment of the Provincial officers.

The Provincial Bye-Laws will be submitted for approval.

**A Collection** will be made for Charitable Purposes.

**The Most Worshipful Pro Grand Master and the Officers** of Grand Lodge will retire in procession.

The Roll of Lodges will be called and the Numbers present announced.

The Provincial Grand Lodge will be closed in due form.
