BY-LAWS

St. Laurence Lodge of Royal Ark Mariners

*Attached to the St. Laurence Lodge of
Mark Master Masons, No. 893*

I.—Meetings of Lodge.

The Lodge shall meet at the Masonic Hall, Northfield, on the second Monday in November, January and March at such times as the W.C.N. may appoint.

II.—Fees and Subscriptions.

The scale of Fees and Subscriptions shall be as follows:—

Elevation Fee, including Registration and Certificate, £1 1s. Joining Fee, 10s. 6d.
Annual Subscription, 10s. 6d.

III.—Ballot.

Candidates for advancement and Joining Members shall be admitted by Ballot in accordance with B.C. 135, 136 and 137, one black ball to exclude.

IV.—Honorary Members.

Distinguished R.A.M. or Brethren who have promoted the welfare of the Lodge may be elected Honorary Members.

V.—Arrears.

Any Member in arrears more than one year shall not be entitled to vote nor to hold office, and it shall be competent for the Lodge to exclude him in accordance with Book of Constitutions.

VI.—Visitors.

Any Member of the Lodge introducing a visitor shall pay such fee for his entertainment as may be fixed by the W.C.(N.).

VII.

The W.C.(N.) shall be elected at the regular meeting in November and installed at the regular meeting in January.

VIII.

The Treasurer shall be elected at the regular meeting in November. He shall keep the Funds of the Lodge and shall pay accounts after they have been approved by the W.C.N., and shall present a duly-audited Balance Sheet and Statement of Accounts at the regular meeting in January.

IX.

Any Member desirous of withdrawing from the Lodge may do so by giving notice in open Lodge or in writing and on payment of all dues shall be entitled to receive a Clearance Certificate.

X.

These By-Laws shall only be altered or added to at a regular meeting of the Lodge. Notice of any alteration or addition must previously have been given in open Lodge and particulars forwarded to every Member

at least seven days before the date of the meeting appointed for the discussion. A majority of the Members present may decide any proposition at such meeting but no alteration or addition shall become effective until it has been confirmed at the subsequent regular meeting and approved by the Royal Ark Council and the Prov. Grand Master.
