ne first regular meeting of the Lodge was held on Monday, Ith July when the first two elevatees were Bro. W. A. F. Barrett and Pro. Dr. C F Henderson.

The meeting of Provincial Grand Lodge was held some fourteen days after the consecration of the Lodge and in the absence of the Worshipful Commander, Bro. H. W. King (S.W.) reported that the Lodge had eleven members, no members had been gained or lost during the year, and the finances of the Lodge was in a "hell of a state".

The Lodge continued to meet on the first Monday of the months of April, May, July and October all of which, with the exception of the May meeting, coincided with the St. Egwin's Lodge of Mark Master Masons, No. 1135. The May meeting being the Installation meeting. This calendar of meetings continued until June 1976 when the members decided that the Lodge should meet on separate dates to the Mark Lodge and the meeting dates were changed to the first Mondays of May, July and November.

Through the years the Lodge has grown from its original eleven founder members to its present subscribing membership of twenty-four. Of the original eleven founder members eight still retain their subscribing membership.

The Lodge has three honorary members, these being R.W. Bro. F. Clifford, Past Provincial Grand Master, V. Wor. Bro. G. E. Rackstraw, Deputy Provincial Grand Master, and Wor.Bro. P. H. Gough, all of whomofficiated at the consecrating ceremoney. V.Wor.Bro. L. H. Weatherhead was also elected an Honorary member at the consecration and was up to the time of his death a very close friend and supporter of the Lodge.
