## BY - LAWS.

- The Regular Meetings of the Chapter shall be held on the 4th Thursday in March and the 3rd Thursdays in June and December at the Masonic Hall, Swan Lane, Evesham in the District of Worcestershire at such times as the Most Wire Sovereign shall direct.
- The election of Sovereign, Treasurer, two Auditors, two junior meabers to serve
  on the standing committee and the Outer Guard shall take place or he March
  meeting and the Enthronement of the Sovereign and the appointing of Officers at
  the June meeting.
- The annual subscription for 1989 due at the June meeting shall be 120.00 and for subsequent years shall be such amount as the Chapter shall certoo by resolution after Notice in the Summons.

- 4. Any member, who, for reasons acceptable to the Claptor is unable regularly to attend meetings may, upon written notice to the decorder and by resolution of the Chapter, be considered a non-dining member and shell pay a reduced subscription of f12-00. When dining the normal dining fit theil be payable.
- 5. In the ballot for membership one black of 1 shall exclude. Prospective candidates shall not be approached until their rame has been submitted to and approved by the Standing Committee.
- them into an account in the name of the Chapter at a bank approved by the members. He shall keep an account of all apper monies, which shall be audited annually by two members elected at the Marci meeting and presented to the Chapter, together with Statement of Account at the December meeting. An inventory of the Chapter property shall be mainted ince and checked annually by the Audit Committee.
- 7. No payers for other than ordinary purposes shall be made from Chapter funds without the sanction of the Chapter by resolution, notice of which shall be given in the Chapter Schools, except in cases of emergency, when the Sovereign may authoris, such a penditure to an amount not exceeding \$50.00 but shall report the matter to the Capter at the next meeting.
- 2. The Soverely. Past Sovereigns of and in the Chapter, the Prelate, Generals, Treasurer and Recorder together with two junior members elected at the March meeting shall form and constitute the Standing Committee. It shall meet by direction of the Sovereign to interview proposed candidates and to deal with all matters referred to it by the Chapter.
- Any matter not dealt with in these By-Laws shall be governed by the Rules and regulations of the Supreme Council.
- 10. No alterations or additions shall be made to these by-laws unless notice thereof has been inserted in the Summons convening the meeting at which such is to be discussed and not less than two thirds of the members present shall vote in favour thereof. Such alteration or addition shall not become effective until approved by the Supreme Council, except mendments to annual subscription which do not require Supreme Council approval.
