ANNUAL REPORT OF THE GENERAL COMMITTEE

The General Committee desires to tender and to record its grateful thanks to R.W.Bro. Arthur A. Johnstone, Provincial Grand Master, Cheshire, Patron of the Institution, on the occasion of his Presidency at the 193rd Anniversary Festival of the Institution held on the 13th May 1981 when, under his inspiring leadership, the funds of the Institution were augmented by the sum of £1,938,850 at the hands of 9,798 Stewards, of which £1,789,864 was contributed by Cheshire Lodges.

The General Committee records its thanks to the Brethren of Cheshire and to those Brethren from London and other Masonic Provinces and Districts who contributed to the financial results achieved; also to the Lady Stewards whose support the Committee much appreciates.

This grand total of £1,938,850 is the highest ever in the history of the Institution as is the average List of £6,151 per Cheshire Lodge, and in recognition of this magnificent achievement. The M.W. Grand Master has formally approved that the Festival Jewel shall be a permanent Jewel for the whole Craft.

It was with great sadness that the Members of the General Committee learned of the deaths of two of their former colleagues in office, both of whom had devoted many years of service to the work of the Institution. W.Brother A. J. Ray, Whiteway, P.S.G.D., who retired in 1979 after eight years membership of the Finance Committee and W.Brother G. M. Lockhart, P.A.G.Reg., who retired in October 1980 after serving on the same Committee for ten years.

The Members also learned with regret of the death of W.Brother Noel Waller, M.B., B.S., M.R.C.S., D.L.O., F.I.C.S., one of the consultant physicians since 1963 and Miss Anne Pennington, a member of the School Educational Policy Committee.

The following Brethren resigned from office during the year: W.Bro. E. K. Smart, J.P., D.Arch. (Hons.), F.I.Arb., L.C.I., Prov. Dep. G.D.C., Middx., from the School Committee due to pressure of business, from the Petitions Committee, W.Bro. G. White-Phillips, M.D., P.I.G.D., after 13 years' service, V.W.Bro. The Rev. Canon Richard Tydeman, M.A., P.G.Chap., after 10 years' service and W.Bro. A. Engelhardt, T.D., after 8 years' service, all due to increasing difficulties with travel to London, having retired from professional life and moved out into the country and V.W.Bro. Colonel A. R. Kiggins, T.D., D.L., J.P., P.G.Swd.B., Dep. Prov. G.M., Essex, after 7 years' service, due to pressure of business. The Members of General Committee accepted these resignations with regret but understanding and unanimously expressed their appreciation of the many years of devoted service all had given to the Institution.

The following new Members have been welcomed: W.Brother I. W. Welsh, M.A., F.C.A., to the School Committee, V.W.Bro. R. S. E. Sandbach, M.A., LL.B., P.G.Swd.B., Dep. Prov. G.M., Northants & Hunts, and W.Brother V. A. Langton, B.Sc., C.Eng., F.C.I.B.S., F.B.I.M., Prov. Dep. G.D.C., Middx., to the Finance Committee, and W.Bro. Dr. O. C. Wilkinson, P.G.Std.B., to the Petitions Committee. W.Bro. G.M. Redman-Brown, P.Dep. G.D.C., Asst. Prov. G.M., Oxon, has agreed to accept co-option to the Finance Committee and will be a candidate at the October 1981 election for membership of the General Committee, as will be W.Bro. Arnold Lever, J.P., P.J.G.D., W.Bro. G. J. Piller, O.B.E., J.P., P.G.Stwd. and W.Bro. H. G. Walker, LL.B. (Ldn.), P.A.G.D.C., each of whom has agreed to accept co-option to the Petitions Committee.

At the General Committee meeting held in February, the members acknowledged with pleasure, the announcement contained in the New Years Honours List that H.M. The Queen had been pleased to appoint W. Brother K. S. Carmichael, Chairman of the Finance Committee, as a Commander of the Order of the British Empire.

The necessary preparatory work for the amalgamation of the R.M.I.G. and R.M.I.B. has continued with excellent progress being made by the joint Working Party. The draft Trust Deed has been prepared and work is now well advanced in the drafting of the associated regulations.

* * * * *

It is inevitable that as living costs in this country continue their upward trend, then the cost of carrying out the work of the Institution increases. The General Committee for its part is always vigilant in its task of controlling the effects of price increases and is ever alert to the importance of introducing economies at every available opportunity.

It is therefore again satisfactory to report a continuation of the trend established in recent years of increasing income whilst maintaining a satisfactory capital growth in the Institution's investment portfolio. The General Committee takes great pleasure in recording its appreciation of the invaluable advice given by the Members of the Investments Committee.

In 1980 the Institution received £109,364 in Legacies and the Committee records its very deep appreciation of the generosity of the donors.

* * * * *

It was reported last year that the Institution had been obliged to undertake major structural repairs to its property at Great Queen Street and at Rickmansworth.

It is now pleasing to report that the internal refurbishing and re-building of three floors at 32 Great Queen Street was satisfactorily completed by the summer of 1980 at considerably less cost than originally estimated. The planned concentration of the office staff to the first floor — possible following this refurbishment — has been achieved and the rebuilt second and third floors let to a new tenant, thus already obtaining a good return from the capital outlay.

At The Rickmansworth Masonic School the essential repair to the roof of the Library was completed on schedule with the minimum of interruption to School routine. The need to replace the whole of the roof to the Science Department is a task of much greater magnitude and will, it is estimated, take some nine months to complete. In order to minimise the inevitable effect on the School programme, the work is planned to begin immediately at the end of the Trinity Term, thus taking advantage of the long summer holiday when the School is closed. It is hoped that this major repair will be completed during Hilary Term 1982.

* * * * *

The School buildings and estate are now 47 years old and the cost of preservation, repair and replacement continues to increase. The engineering services and plant providing heat, hot water and electricity are approaching the end of their economic life and will, in the near future, need complete replacement by new installations of such design as to achieve maximum efficiency and financial economy.

The demand therefore on the Institution's financial resources in the immediate future will, unavoidably, be heavier than in previous years.

* * * * *

It has long been the intention to re-house the medical facilities for the School within the administration building, thus releasing the now under-utilised sanatorium for other purposes.

The General Committee has agreed to a proposal that the sanatorium be converted into a new House specifically for use by girls in the VIth form, thus following a modern trend in schools throughout the country. This work was approved at a special meeting in April and is scheduled for completion and re-occupation by the School in time for the

opening of Michaelmas Term 1981. The new House, which has yet to be named, will provide VIth form boarding and day accommodation for some 120 girls. It is the intention so to improve the facilities for VIth form girls, that more will be attracted to the School and those already at Rickmansworth encouraged to remain in order to complete a full academic preparation to 'A' level standard.

Authority has also been given for conversion work in the administration building to provide, on the first floor, the new medical centre and on the second floor a further ten study bedrooms to supplement those being constructed in the sanatorium project. This move will take back into full use, the two floors of the administration building which had been in only partial occupation since the construction of the staff accommodation of Bertha Dean and Florence Mason Houses.

A further long term gain from these conversion projects, which increase the study capacity of the School, is that they will permit of a further development, should the need be proven, for the re-establishment of provision for a junior entry in the age range of eight to ten years.

* * * * *

Mr. D. L. Curtis, M.A. (Cantab.), whose appointment as the first Headmaster of The Rickmansworth Masonic School was announced in the report for 1980, took up his duties at the beginning of Michaelmas Term last year. The General Committee in welcoming him and Mrs. Curtis, look forward to the years ahead and the further progress at Rickmansworth heralded by his arrival.

Dr. C. S. Artley, M.A., Ph.D., L. ès L., joined the Staff at the School in December 1980 on being appointed Deputy Head vice Miss J. F. Earl. The General Committee welcome Dr. Artley and her family into the community at Rickmansworth and wish her every success in her work.

The second year of operation as a School admitting fee paying students in general, has seen a continuation of the satisfactory upward trend in the number of admissions and registrations. The Michaelmas Term 1980 opened with a total of 334 boarding and 112 day girls and that academic year ended in July 1981 with totals of 355 and 120 respectively, an increase of 29 girls. The anticipated number in the School at Michaelmas Term 1981 is 520.

* * * * *

The girls now receiving the benefits of the Institution continue to remain fairly constant and total 486. Of this number, 58 are in receipt of grants supplementing those given by local education authorities whilst attending places of higher education, colleges and universities, 41 are in receipt of special grants whilst attending training centres covering a very wide field of professions and trades.

This year 15 have successfully graduated from University and 1 has qualified at teacher training college. In the General Certificate of Education, taken at the School, 59 obtained passes at 'O' Level and 26 at 'A' Level. In addition, 35 obtained various grades in the C.S.E. examinations. Of the out-educated girls, 12 obtained passes at 'O' Level and 13 at 'A' Level.

* * * * *

Sports Day was held on Saturday, the 4th July, when the prizes were most graciously presented by Lady Atkinson, deputising at very short notice, for Mrs. A. A. Murphy. The weather was marvellous, contributing to a most successful day thoroughly enjoyed by all concerned — staff, pupils and spectators.

The General Committee wishes to place on record its grateful thanks to the Secretary, the Assistant Secretary and the Staff at Headquarters, also to the Headmaster and his Staff for their loyal and competent service during the year.

Finally, the Committee wishes to remind Brethren and Subscribers that the 194th Anniversary Festival will be held on 12th May 1982 under the Presidency of R.W. Bro. Fredk. H. Griffiths, Provincial Grand Master for Worcestershire. It is earnestly hoped that all who can do so will support the Festival.
