




Under no less a penalty

- Q. Wt manner of man are you ? Ans: I am a mason.
Q. How shall I know that ? Ans: By ye signs tokens & points of my entry.
Q. Where were you entered ? Ans: In a full and perfect lodge.
Q. What makes a full and perfect lodge ? Ans: three masters, three fellow crafts , and three enterprentices.
Q. How stands your lodge ? Ans: East and West like ye Temple of J Jerusalem.
Q. Where sits ye Master ? Ans: In a chair of bone in ye middle of a four square pavement.
Q. What sits he there for ? Ans: To observe the suns rising to see to set his men to work.
Q. How high is your Lodge ? Ans: As high as ye stars inches and feet innumerable.
Q. Where do you keep the key of your lodge ? Ans: In a box of bone within a foot and $\frac{1}{2}$ of ye lodge door.
Q. How far is it from ye cable to ye anchor ? Ans: As far as from ye tongue to ye heart.
Q. Which way blows ye wind ? Ans: East and west & out of ye South

The common sign is with your right hand rub yr mouth then cross yr throat and lay it on ye left breast / The masters sign is backbone : ye word Matchpin / The fellow craftsmen sign is / knuckles and sinues ye word Jachquin , The enterprentices sign is sinues the word / Boaz or its hollow . Squeeze the master by ye back bone , put your knee between his , and say Matchpin . Squeeze the fellow craftsman in knuckles , and sinues and say Jachquin / Squeeze the enterprentice in sinues and say boaz , or its hollow. To know in ye dark if there be a mason in company , Say ye day was made for seeing , and ye night for hearing / if you are amongst the fraternity and they drink to you , turn ye top of the glass down / and if after two or three times so doing they say drink and I'll warrant you . then they will / pay your clubb. or if you say ye squire is lean , or throw a tobacco stopper to one of them / and say change me ye groat, and they will pay your club. To send for a brother the / signes are these  . If you say ye lodge is untiled, that is as / much as to say there is someone in ye company you suspect for a brother, . / To bring a man from a scaffold , or any other place hold ye heels together / and yr toes open , and look up , and then with yr hand or Cane make a right angle / . this as all other notions must be done very carelessly.
