Dark Morning Dress or Uniform. Full Masonic Craft Clothing.

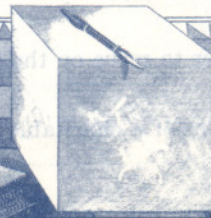
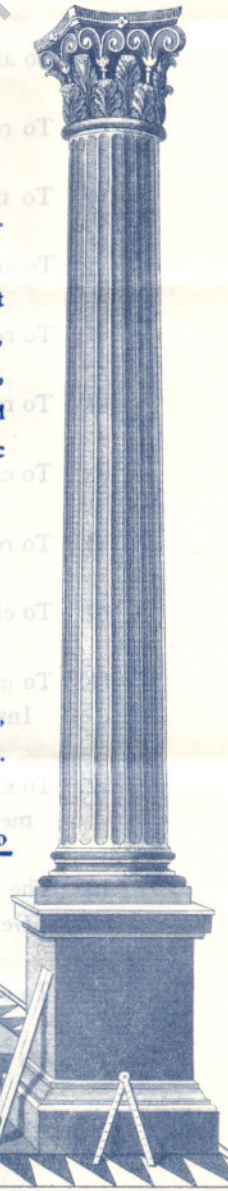
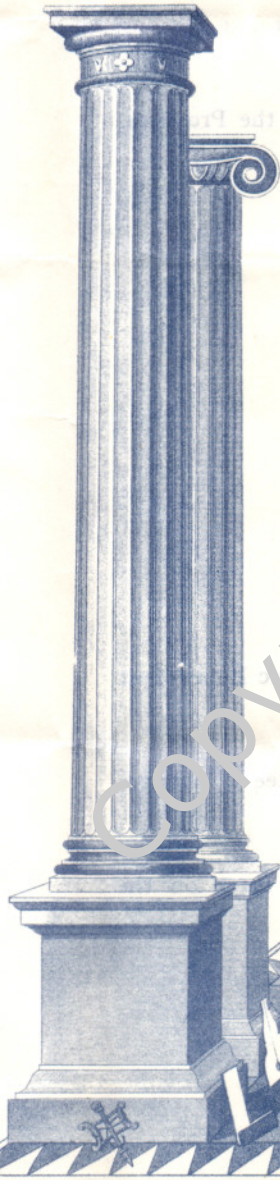
Great and Royal Arch jewels only to be worn.

14. To elect one member to serve on the General Committee under By-law No. 6.
15. To make a collection for a charitable purpose.
