- 3. The Consecrating and Installing Officer via instruct his Office-Bearers to take up their respective positions in the Lodge Room.
- 4. District Grand Lodge will be opened in the First Degree.
- 5. District Grand Lodge will be opened in the Second Degree.
- 6. District Grand Lodge win be opened in the Third Degree.
- 7. The Chaplain win offer up prayer :-

From henceforth it is fully empowered to exercise all its rights and privileges agreeably to the terroin of its Charter, the Constitution and Laws of Grand Lodge, and the ancient usages of the Fraternity."


