The Rt. Worshipful Installing Master and the Officers of Grand Lodge will enter in Procession.

The Rt. Worshipful Installing Master will take the Chair, appoint his Officers, and be saluted.

The Rt. Worshipful Installing Master will be informed that the Provincial Grand Master Designate is without, and requests to be installed.

- The Rt. Worshipful Installing Master will request that the Patent of approval and appointment by the M.W. Grand Master be produced to him.
- The Grand Director of Ceremonies will retire and re-enter with the Patent, which he will present for inspection by the Installing Master.
- The Rt. Worshipful Installing Master will direct that the Provincial Crand Master Designate be introduced in proper form.
- The Grand Director of Ceremonies and certain appointed Bothien will retire, and, preceded by Brethren bearing the Regalia, will re-enter the L dge, introducing the Provincial Grand Master Designate.
