A.L. 589 A.D. 1891.

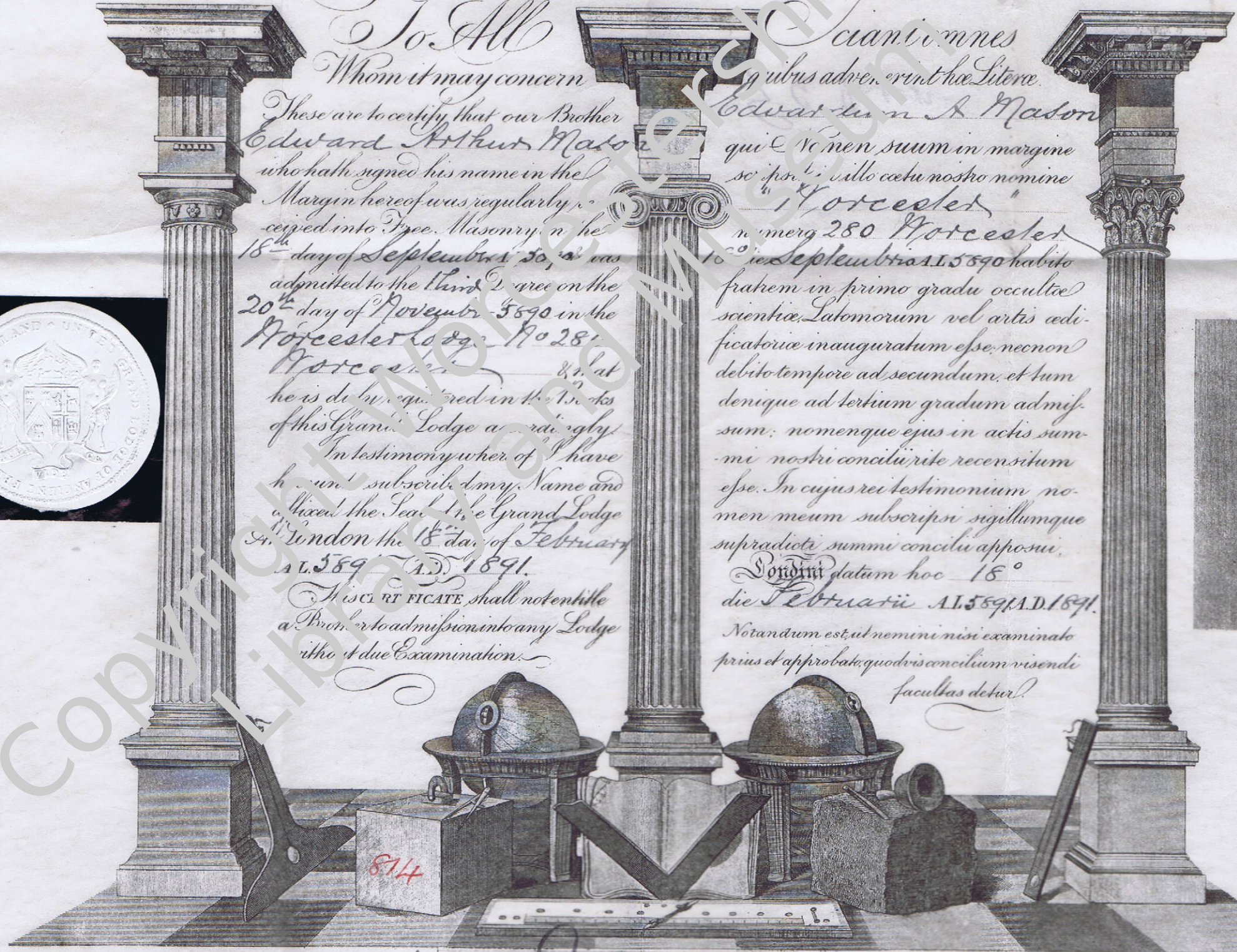
