

ORDER OF DEMOLAY

This order takes its name from Jacques deMolay (1243-1314) last Grand Master of the Knight Templars who was burnt at the stake in front of Notre Dame Paris at the instigation of Philip IV of France (Philip the fair!!) and Pope Clement V

It was founded in Kansas City in 1919 and membership is for boys between the ages of 14 and 21, chiefly the sons of Freemasons

Its purpose is the development of good citizenship and character by inculcating the virtues of comradeship, reverence, love of parents patriotism and fidelity

However it cannot guarantee future acceptance into Freemasonry
