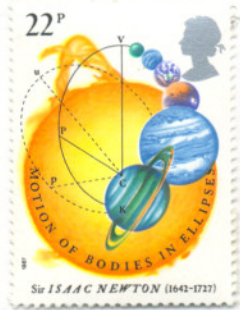


# A MASONIC MATHEMATICIAN?

## Sir ISAAC NEWTON

SIR ISAAC NEWTON (1642 - 1727) English Natural Philosopher and Mathematician. Most learned Scientist of his day. Member of Parliament in 1689-1701-2. There is no evidence that he was a Mason, but many of his close friends were, and he is often credited with Membership. Many English Lodges are named after him, the most notable being Sir Isaac Newton, Grantham.
