To honour Him by votive hands,
With streams of corn, and wing, and il.

The Consecrating Officer pours Oil: the Symbol of Place and Unaninity. Musical Response—Glory be to God on high.

The Chaplain reads Leviticus, chap. ii, verse 13

The Brethren sing:

Now o'er on work this salt we shower, Embler of Thy conservant power; And may Thy Presence; Lo. I we pray Keep this our Territor of decay.

The Consecrating Officer sprinkle: Salt: the Symbol of Fidelity and Friendship. Musical Response—Glory te to God on high.
