A. Thexton, seconded by E. Comp. Jas. Thomson, F.A.G.D.C., Scribe E.; and Charles Alfred Jenkins, Founder and Org., Lodge Freedom and Courtesy, No. 4762, aged 45 years, Company Secretary and Director, 139, Woodland Avenue, Leytonstone, E.11, proposed by E.
