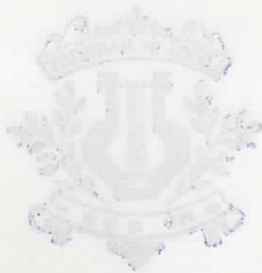
Master Masons are invited to be present but will not be allowed to vote on any matters brought before Prov. Grand Lodge.
